House points

- ▶ House points are given for:
- ▶ An exceptional piece of work or exceptional progress, including demonstrating a growth mindset
- ▶ Observing the school Heart Values
- ▶ A marked improvement in behaviour
- ▶ An exceptional attitude/activity above and beyond what is expected
- ▶ If you win the class table points each week you will receive 5 bonus house points each.

Collecting House Points

- ▶ We're not going to collect individual House Points anymore.
- ▶ From now on we will have 1 House Point collection chart for each House. You will work together with everyone in your House to collect and put your Housepoints up.
- ▶ Each week there will be a House Point winner and we will keep a track of how many House Points each house has on the school website. There will be an overall winner every half term.

The Beechwood HEART Value Red Stickers

You can receive two HEART stickers a day.

Any adult around the school can give HEART stickers for positive behaviour such as:

- ✓ Working within the Heart Values
- ✓ Demonstrating a growth mind-set attitude towards their learning
- ✓ Co-operating and following instructions
- ✓ Demonstrating good behaviour
- ✓ Working hard and achieving well
- ✓ Improving or meeting a target
- ✓ Showing initiative
- ✓ Demonstrating good manners



The Beechwood HEART Value Gold Sticker

When you have achieved a Red HEART sticker and go above and beyond what is expected of you either in your learning or around the school you will be able to receive a HEART value Gold sticker from any adult.



The Beechwood HEART Value Gold Sticker

When you have achieved a Red HEART sticker and a Gold HEART sticker and continue to go above and beyond what is expected of you either in your learning or around the school you will be sent to a member of SLT for a HEART Rainbow sticker.

We still have:

Headteacher's Award

Every week each class teacher will select two children for a Headteacher's Award certificate. These will be given out for a really good piece of work or demonstrating a special learning behaviour.

▶ Growth Mindset Award

- ▶ Every week each class teacher will select one child for a Growth Mindset certificate for demonstrating one of our six Growth Mindset skills.

▶ ENQUIRE PERSEVERE CREATE

▶ ACT COURAGE REFLECT

We will also send badges and activities on Marvellous Me



- ▶ We might send a Marvellous Me for:
- ▶ An activity or lesson that has been successful or interesting so you can talk to your families about it
- ▶ A Gold HEART Sticker
- ▶ A Rainbow HEART Sticker
- ▶ Maths Sheriff Badges
- ▶ Growth Mindset Awards
- ▶ Head Teacher's Awards
- ▶ If your House gets the most House Points each week

What about if things aren't going so well?

- ▶ If you are not making the right choices around the school you will be giving a pre-warning which will mean an adult will give you the chance to change your behaviour.
- ▶ If this doesn't stop the unacceptable behaviour you will be sent to work at the Reflection Station in your classroom. There is a 5 minute timer so you know how long you have and it is a chance for you to reflect on our HEART values and work out how you can start again and be successful. (We will keep a track of how often you are using the Reflection Station)
- ▶ If this still doesn't stop the unacceptable behaviour you will be sent to another classroom in your year group for a 'Time out' and a chance to talk to another adult about why things aren't going well.
- ▶ If you are still struggling to make the right choices after this then you will be sent to a member of SLT to for a time out and you will be expected to catch up on any lost learning time.

- Talking and not paying attention
- Making silly noises
- Not listening
- Inappropriately calling out
- Disrupting the learning of others
- Refusing to work
- Not lining up appropriately
- Arguing with peers/adults
- Ignoring adults
- Defiance
- Generally not being safe, responsible, respectful or a good learner.

Serious Behaviours

- ▶ If something happens which is a Serious Behaviour you will be sent straight to a member of SLT to discuss what has happened and to discuss the consequences of what has happened.
- ▶ This might be a detention at break, lunchtime or occasionally after school.
- ▶ You will be expected to make up any lost learning.
- ▶ We will tell your parents what has happened and sometimes we might meet with them.

Examples might be:

- Fighting
- Swearing
- Bullying
- Destroying school property or someone else's property
- Spitting

What about on the playground?

- ▶ You will be given a pre-warning and a chance to change or stop the unacceptable behaviour.
- ▶ If you choose not to take this chance and change the behaviour you will be sent to the office as a Serious Behaviour.
