








Realistic	 <p>Realistic or the style of artistic realism is accurately representing what is natural or real convincingly to appear natural.</p>
		Unrealistic	 <p>Unrealistic is deliberately inaccurately representing what is natural or real.</p>
		Shape	 <p>A shape is an enclosed space. A two-dimensional form that has both length and width. Shapes are one of the seven elements of art, the building blocks that artists use to create images on canvas and in our minds.</p>
		Fine	 <p>Very thin or narrow.</p>
		Adapt	 <p>To make or become suitable, especially to change to fit a new or specific use or situation. To change from original shape.</p>
		Patterned	 <p>A pattern is a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated. The part that is repeated is called a motif. Patterns can be regular or irregular.</p>
		Uneven	 <p>Not level, equal, flat, or continuous.</p>
		Rough	 <p>Having an uneven or irregular surface; not smooth or level. Not finished tidily or decoratively; plain and basic.</p>
