






## Year 3 - RE- Ceremony- Sikhism- Golden Thread- Special

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can give an example of how a given concept is shown within a religion.</li> <li>I can explain the meaning of the concept of 'celebration' (year 1) and identify how this is shown in some religions.</li> <li>I can identify how key religious festivals are celebrated through ceremonies (Christmas, Easter).</li> <li>I can begin to reflect on important issues and talk about my feelings.</li> <li>I can identify a ceremony that I have watched or been involved in.</li> <li>I can understand, explain and give some examples of the concept of 'Special' (Year 2)</li> </ul>	<p><u>Inquire</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can explain that ceremonies can have a different meaning/ value depending on the purpose.</li> <li>I can identify and provide an example of how a ceremony is different to a party for example.</li> </ul> <p><u>Contextualise</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can give examples of how and why the Dasta Bandi and naming ceremonies are considered important to Sikh's.</li> <li>I can give examples of the things that make a Sikh ceremony special and why this is important to a person of faith.</li> </ul> <p><u>Evaluate</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can express how a Sikh may feel if they were not able to keep to their traditional ceremonies.</li> <li>I can express how and why I might feel a certain way about ceremonies I have seen or been a part of in my life.</li> </ul> <p><u>Communicate</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can express how the concept of ceremonies makes me feel.</li> <li>I can give an example of why the ceremony was important and give an example of how the importance is shown.</li> <li>I can give opinions as to what I think makes an effective ceremony and the meaning behind it.</li> </ul> <p><u>Apply</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can describe how my response to concept of ceremonies relates to my life and those of others.</li> <li>I can discuss how the value of a ceremony is shown and how this can differ in different situations.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Gudwara</b></p> 	<p>The place where Sikhs come together for worship.</p>
		<p><b>Langar</b></p> 	<p>The community kitchen of a gurdwara, which serves meals to all free of charge</p>
		<p><b>Dastar</b></p> 	<p>The name of a turban worn by men in the Sikh religion. It covers a man's head and protects it from getting tangled or dirty.</p>
		<p><b>The Guru Granath Sahib</b></p> 	<p>The Sikh holy book. It is a collection of teachings.</p>
		<p><b>Equality</b></p> 	<p>All members of the Sikh community are seen as equal.</p>
