

I can find out what damages teeth and how to look after them 	<p><u>Digestion</u></p> 	<p>The process of breaking down food</p>
		<p><u>Predator</u></p> 	<p>An animal that preys on others</p>
		<p><u>Producer</u></p> 	<p>The name given to a living thing that produces its own food rather than consuming another living thing</p>
		<p><u>Prey</u></p> 	<p>An animal that is caught and killed by another for food</p>
		<p><u>Canine</u></p> 	<p>A pointed tooth between the incisors and premolars of a mammal, often greatly enlarged in carnivores</p>
		<p><u>Incisor</u></p> 	<p>A narrow-edged tooth at the front of the mouth, adapted for cutting.</p>
