		<p>Protection</p> 	<p>To guard, shield or take steps to maintain someone's safety.</p>
		<p>Community</p> 	<p>People living in one particular area or considered to be a unit because of their common interests, social group or nationality.</p>
		<p>Family</p> 	<p>A group of two or more people who love and care for one another. They can be legally related through birth, marriage or adoption.</p>
