**Year 4 Residential Visit to Stubbington Study Centre
22nd to 26th June 2026**

We have arranged an exciting residential visit for our Year 4 children for this academic year. We are able to offer 50 children the opportunity to go to Stubbington Study Centre from 22nd to 26th June 2026.

Stubbington has long been established and used by thousands of local pupils over many years. The children will be sleeping in dormitories with a member of staff on hand. They have 3 filling meals a day, lots of fun, educational activities and learn to become more independent. I have never heard of any child who has not had a great time there. They even get the opportunity to sneak out at night in their pyjamas and watch badgers, from a hide, which is magic!

The cost of this residential is £300.00. This includes all of the children's meals, their activities and the coach to get them there and back again. In the Summer term, we will hold a parent's information evening where you will be able to find out more about the trip including the itinerary for the week and items your child will need to pack. The date of the information evening will be sent out in due course.

If your child is successful in gaining a place you will be notified week commencing 10th November and you will be required to pay a £50.00 deposit by Friday 28th November 2025. There are only 50 places available on this trip and it is very popular. If your child is not allocated a place their name will be placed on a waiting list in case a place becomes available. Please be aware that if your child secures a place on the trip, you must ensure that the total cost of £300.00 has been paid by Monday 1st June 2026. Refunds will not be given for any reason if your child does not subsequently take part.

All subsequent payments can be made by on-line instalments. The instalment dates will follow. A child's place may be withdrawn if their behaviour or attendance in school is not as it should be, or if the payments for their place are not made on time with no agreement in place between you and the school.
