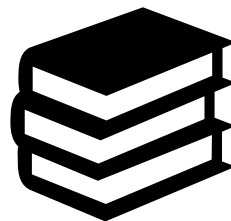

Bronze 25 logs on Boom

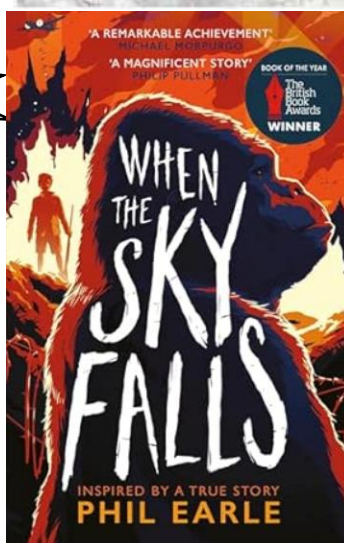
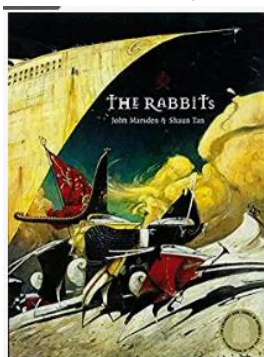
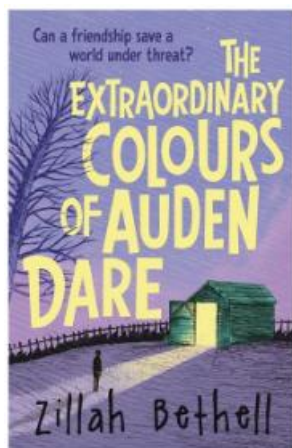
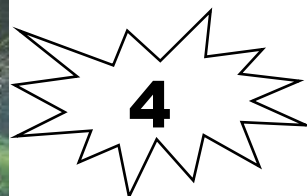
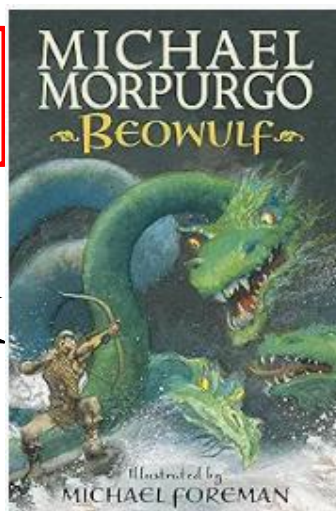
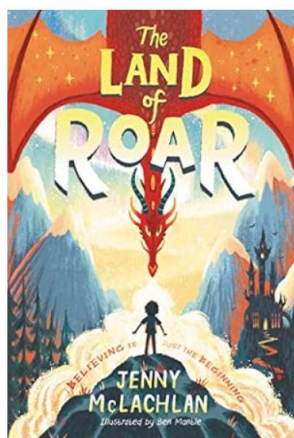
Silver 35 logs on Boom

These are the texts we will be reading in Spring One.





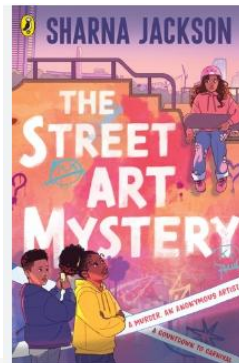
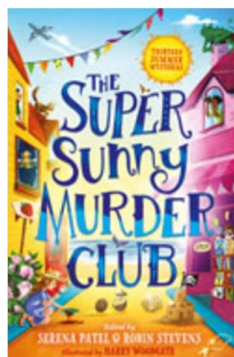
