Dear Parents / Carers

As the weather gets warmer and the end of the school year approaches our thoughts turn to the Autumn term!

10th July 3:30 pm – new to Year 5

6th July 3:30 pm – new to Year 6

The year group team will do a short 20-minute presentation about themselves and the curriculum the children will be learning.
