RE: Year 3 Workshops

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share another exciting opportunity coming up for our Year 3 children during the summer term.

Later in the term, we will be welcoming The Past Presents, linked to our history topic on the Romans. This experience will take place on **Thursday 16th July**. During this immersive workshop, children will explore why the Romans invaded Britain and compare Roman life with that of the Celtic tribes. Through hands-on activities such as dressing up, problem-solving, and re-enacting key historical events, pupils will gain a deeper understanding of Roman soldiers, daily life in the Empire, and the significance of arenas and battles.

To make this experience as immersive as possible, we are inviting children to come dressed in Roman attire on the day. There is absolutely no expectation to purchase anything new - we love seeing creative, homemade costumes. Here are a few simple ideas:

- A Roman toga made from an old white sheet or pillowcase, draped and secured with a belt or ribbon
- A simple tunic made from an oversized T-shirt, tied at the waist
- Cardboard accessories such as shields or helmets, decorated with paint, pens, or foil

If your child chooses not to dress up, please ensure they come to school in their usual school uniform.

These experiences promise to be highly engaging and will greatly enhance the children's learning across science and history.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £7 to help us cover the cost of the activity.

Please note that contributions are voluntary and no child will be excluded from participating if a contribution is not made. However, if we do not receive enough contributions overall, we may need to review whether the activities can go ahead.
